Department of Biology – Sessional Lecture Instructor

Brandon University is seeking a sessional lecture instructor in the Department of Biology to teach one lecture section (3hours/week) of **15:269 Microbiology** from September to December 2021. Qualified candidates must possess strong teaching, communication and organizational skills.

Responsibilities include:

- Preparing and delivering lectures of the 2nd year Microbiology course for Biology majors.
- Evaluating students for the lecture component of the course, and compiling marks for the lecture and laboratory components of the course.

The normal mode of course delivery is in-person; however, given the uncertainties inherent in the current pandemic, applicants should also be prepared to teach in an online synchronous format.

Lecture schedule: Monday, Wednesday, Friday 9:30-10:20am

Qualifications: Completion of M.Sc, Ph.D. preferred, and demonstrated knowledge of Microbiology. Prior experience in Microbiology instruction or equivalent would be an asset.
